 Convention: Erika presented a full report on the Annual Convention. Confirmation of date and venues: Emperors Palace, Gauteng. 16-17 November 2011. Theme will be Black or Bright and is used for all marketing material and received great response. 	
• International involvement: Erika referred to Prof LJ's statement regarding the involvement of the IEEE in the SAEEC and explained that the Convention was now being marketed internationally.	
• Registration and fees : An escalation of 10% to the prices was introduced but it is still a relatively inexpensive convention to attend. Two paid delegates have been registered.	
• Exhibitors : 1 523 companies in the energy industry have been identified as possible exhibitors. 13 out of 45 Exhibitor stands were sold (3 new companies). The exhibitors up to date are:
